2022 Global Australian Awards showcase Australian diaspora leading impact on the global stage

The achievements and contributions of 34 remarkable Australians driving global impact are being recognised and celebrated in the lead up to the 2022 Global Australian Awards.

The Global Australian Awards, presented by <u>Advance Global Australians</u>, recognise the soft power and significant influence of global Australians and international alumni of Australian universities, who are leading crucial advancements on the global stage in industries critical to Australia.

The 34 finalists recognised in this year's Awards work across Asia, Europe, and North America. They join more than 160 eminent Australians who have been recognised as Advance Gamechangers in the Global Australian Awards (previously known as the Advance Awards) over the past 11 years.

Advance Global Australians CEO Johanna Pitman said: "The Global Australian Awards celebrate the often unknown Australian changemakers driving impact across their professions, industries and sectors around the world.

"This year's finalists are tackling global challenges with purpose and persistence, working at the cutting edge of their professions. Through their work and leadership, they are collectively advancing human progress, protecting our planet, exploring new ones, driving social change, and above all, advocating for equality, justice and human rights.

"From scientists to storytellers, mathematicians to musicians, corporate leaders to policy makers, entertainers to entrepreneurs, academics to artists - this year's Global Australian Awards finalists are heroes hidden in plain sight. Advance is proud to shine the spotlight on their incredible impact around the world and build deeper connections with these remarkable Australians back here in Australia."

The winners of each category will be announced during a free, live broadcast at 7:30pm AEST, 7 September. The 2022 Global Australian of the Year, selected by the judging from across the category winners, will be announced during the broadcast. The Awards broadcast will also be available to all Australians via YouTube and ABC iView following the event.



The Global Australian Awards are the only of their kind to recognise the contributions of the Australian diaspora – the 1 million Australians living abroad and 2.5 million former international students of Australian universities. This year's Awards also includes a new category recognising recent migrants to Australia who are having an outsized impact in future-facing industries.
